**Religion:** Jesus died so that we will have new life in heaven. An example of new life that we see is a butterfly. Just as Jesus came out of the tomb with a new life, the caterpillar enters the chrysalis and comes out a butterfly. The new life we see in spring and the new life of the butterfly remind us of Jesus' new life. Jesus wants us to share His love. Think about one way you will share Jesus's love with someone and then do it.

**Math:** Continue practicing addition and subtraction.

Continue playing [Bubble Buster](#) to practice combinations of 10.

Listen to this [Skip Counting Song](#) and [this Counting by 2s song](#) to learn and practice counting by 2s.

IXL: D13 (Count forward and backward to 20), F1 (Learn to skip count by 2s), H6 (Growing Patterns), J5 (Add 2 Numbers) and L1 (Subtract with cubes).

**English/Language Arts:** Sight words this week: **soon, new, ride**. These words will be introduced during our Zoom meeting on Tuesday.

Write each word 5 times, and write a sentence using each word on at least 3 days.

Check your folder for the pink paper titled Week of 4/27 for a worksheet with sentences which your child will complete using the work box at the top of the page.

IXL assignment: Kindergarten Language Arts: F3 (Rhyming), G3 (Put the sounds in order), L2 (short i), L4 (short i) and U2 (What will happen next).
