**Science:** 1. Float or Sink Activity

*Materials needed:* Tub of water; small items that float (examples: feather, bottle cap, unifix cube piece of aluminum foil); small items that sink (examples: pebble, penny, marble, toy fish); towels.

*Set up:* Give your child a tub of water and tell him/her to test several things to see if they float or sink. Start by passing one item at a time and ask to make predictions whether he/she thinks the item will float or sink. Next, tell your child to put that item in the water to see what happens. Have your child test each item in the same manner.
