Religion: We will be continuing to work on how small changes can make a big difference. If your child has not read session 24 in their book please have them and complete the worksheet on classkick called We Want Some Good News.

Math: We will be starting a new Unit this week and our focus will be on Fractions. We will zoom on Monday the 18th and Wednesday the 20th for Math. Lesson 7-1 is on Liquid Volume and Lesson 7-2 is on Exploring Arrays, Volume and Equal Shares. There will be a video and worksheets on classkick.

English/Language Arts: **Reading**: We will be starting a new story this week called Life on the Ice, this is an informational Text Story about traveling through the Artic Circle. They will need to read pages 164-165 for their vocabulary words, pages 166-167 for our skills this week (Main Ideas and Details) and the strategy (Infer and Predict), the main story starts on page 168-185, make sure they read the captions to help understand the photographs. They will also need to read pages 186-187 to help them analyze the text. We will go over all of this in our Zoom Class on Monday. **Grammar**: We will be focusing on Adverbs this week, adverbs that tell how, where, and when. Phonics/Spelling: We will be decoding compound words this week; they should remember that these are one word made up of two smaller words. Science: Students watched a video on Foss =Webb last week about Water and Density, this week they will need to read "Water: Hot and Cold" in their books on pages 21-23 and complete the worksheets on classkick.

Social Studies: We will be continuing Chapter 5 in our book this week is Lesson 2: A River Community. They will need to read pages 150-155 in their Social Studies book and complete worksheets pg. 55 & 56 on classkick.
