Art: 1. Use the playdough and make capital/lowercase "L/l"

2. *Fingerprint and handprint apple tree art.* Gather the materials: Paper; brown, red, and yellow paint; comb; green paper; scissors; glue stick

The tree trunk- add brown paint to a large piece of paper and drag a comb through it. Lay the finished painting aside to dry.

The handprint leaves- trace your child's hand on the green paper and cut it out. Make as many "leaves" as you want. Glue the "leaves" to the top of the trunk.

Apple fingerprints- let the child dip the fingers into the paint and make fingerprint red and yellow apples all over the leaves.
